

**Village of Clifton Council Meeting**  
October 13, 2025

The Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve McFarland. Roll call was as follows:

Also present were Noah Stuby, Charlie Tate, Jim Fiessinger, and Jerry and Donna Huckleba.

Noah Stuby, Deputy Health Commissioner from Greene County talked to Council about the activities of the Greene County Public Health Department. They provide resources as well as services. They will be conducting a community health assessment, so some may receive a survey. This will help develop strategies for the future. Council members expressed a desire to have the village treated for mosquitos in the future. Mr Stuby emphasized that many of the services required by the state are not funded by the state and so local funds are needed to cover 40% of their budget. A renewal levy will be on the ballot in November.

The minutes from the September meeting were approved following a motion from Lazorski, second from Tate, and all members present voting aye. The September Financial report was accepted unanimously following a motion by Lewis and second from Lazorski. Payment of the bills for September, including \$490 for solicitor services, was approved unanimously following a motion by Tate and second by Lewis.

**In Old Business:**

**In Village Repairs:**

Renovation work will increase at the **Opera House** over the next few weeks with scaffolding being put in place. Work should begin on replacing the windows at the **School** as well. The **MTFD** will soon remove the remaining items of interest to them soon. Anything left the village will be permitted to dispose of as desired according to Chief Jim Cannell. The **office space** in the Firehouse is available for rent.

The concession stand will need to be winterized after Halloween. The state contractor may need to do that.

**In Other Old Business:**

The **Planning and Zoning** Commission will meet next on November 3. The village solicitor is working with information provided by the village.

**In New Business:**

Beggars' Night plans were discussed. The activity will be Friday, October 31 with trick-or-treating starting at 6:00 and food and hayrides at the shelter starting at 7:00.

A nerf game activity is planned at the shelter sponsored by the Dayton Nerf Association on Saturday, October 25. A Volksmarch is taking place on Saturday, October 18 starting at the firehouse. Restrooms in the firehouse will be made available for both events.

Clerk-Treasurer Chasnov was designated to represent Council members at various training sessions following a motion from Lazorski and second from Nicewaner and all members voting aye.

**In Special Project Business:**

The **Opera House** financial report for September was presented. Volunteers are needed for performances.

The **Preservation Society of Clifton** will meet on October 21.

A final financial report was prepared for this year's **Festival**. Council approved contracts for the 2026 Festival with an increase in the vendor fee to \$65 per space.

As there was no further business, Lazorski moved to close the meeting. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
