

Village of Clifton Council Special Meeting
Regarding Post Office Closure
December 22, 2025

The Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve McFarland. Roll call was as follows:

With the village being given about two weeks notice of the closure of the post office, Council met to discuss what to propose to the USPS to allow residents to receive mail in the village again.

After discussing the ramifications of the closure and the options for moving forward, it was proposed that we suggest to the USPS that the boxes be moved in to the now available space in the smaller, partially enclosed bay at the old firehouse. Due to the importance of this solution and the fact that the USPS would take a year or more to accomplish the needed renovations, it will be suggested that the village be allowed to make the necessary renovations. Nicewaner moved to make this suggestion to the USPS. Lewis seconded the motion and all members voted aye. Involvement of the village solicitor may incur additional expenses, so Nicewaner moved to appropriate \$500 for this. Satariano seconded the motion and all members voted aye.

As there was no further business, Satariano moved to close the meeting. Lazorski seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
