

**Village of Clifton Council Meeting**  
February 9, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Steve McFarland. Roll call was as follows:

**In Old Business:**

The minutes from the January meeting were approved following a motion from Nicewaner, second from Lazorski, and all members voting aye. The January Financial report was accepted unanimously following a motion by Lazorski and second from Lewis. Payment of the bills for January was approved unanimously following a motion by Lazorski and second by Satariano.

**In Village Repairs:**

Renovation work continues at the **Opera House** and **School**. Council has been asked to approve engaging a consultant to examine the plans for the work being done and perform inspections for approval. A memorandum of understanding with the consultant was considered for acceptance. Lazorski moved to approve the MOU. Satariano seconded the motion and all members voted aye. Plans to rent the spaces in the school are needed. The attorney will be dealing with the Old Timers with their lease. The need to replace a removed beam in the former Shoebox Theatre was mentioned.

**In Other Old Business:**

Work continues on the work to transform the fire station bay for the **post office boxes**. Nicewaner moved that the space be named "**Clifton Village Mail Station**". Lazorski seconded the motion and all members voted aye. Lazorski moved to appropriate \$3,000 for purchasing supplies. Lewis seconded the motion and all members voted aye.

**In New Business:**

Council designated Mayor McFarland to represent the Village on the **Greene County Public Health Advisory Council**.

Lazorski moved to approve **Ordinance #26-2-1** adopting the **Ohio Basic Code** for 2026. Satariano seconded the motion and all members voted aye.

**Dates** were set for activities for the Village in 2026:

- Easter Egg Hunt - April 4
- Village Clean-up week - May 9- 17
- Landscaping Day - May 16
- Village Garage Sale - May 30
- July Picnic - July 4
- Beggars' Night - October 31

Council approved moving the **notice board location** from the old post office to the new mail station after a motion from Satariano and second from Lewis with all members approving.

Council will work on an ordinance to help control the practice of charging for **parking** during the **Christmas Lights** which has expanded too far. Parked vehicles extending too far into the street is also a problem.

**In Special Project Business:**

Satariano moved to make appropriations to start up the season at the **Opera House** including: \$690 for advertisement, \$240 start up cash, \$500 for concessions, and \$200 for maintenance. Lewis seconded the motion and all members voted aye. Volunteers will be needed to help with shows and setting up for food sales.

The **Preservation Society** of Clifton plans to meet on April 15.

The **Festival** Committee met on January 26. Corporate and music sponsors and advertisers are being sought. Satariano moved to appropriate funds including: Cruise-in \$250, Advertisement \$800, Booklet (design & print) \$1,500, Correspondence \$300, Signs/Banners \$400, DJ/Sound \$250, Food \$200, Misc. \$500, T-shirts \$300, water test \$100. Lazorski seconded the motion and all members voted aye. Appropriations for Entertainment and Beer will be determined at a later date.

As there was no further business, Lazorski moved to close the meeting. Lewis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.
